1. Does the COAG Reform Council produce a newsletter? If so, how often is it produced?

- 2. How many copies of the newsletter are printed and at what cost?

Answer:

- Yes. The Council of Australian Governments Reform Council (The Council) issues a newsletter with each public report launch (about 12-15 per year).
 Newsletters are also issued for occasions considered newsworthy such as new councillor appointments or to inform subscribers of events.
- 2. The Council does not print any newsletters, they are issued electronically.
- 3. As at 13 June 2014, 1533 email addresses were subscribed to the newsletter.
- 4. The initial template design was created by a graphic design company. Copy and images are placed in the template by secretariat staff to create newsletters.
