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Question:

Senator LUNDY: Would you please provide a breakdown, by state and territory, of classification, gender, age, category of employment, duration of employment and reason for leaving of all separations since September 2013.

Mr Sedgwick: I suspect not, to be honest, but we will do what we can for you.

Senator LUNDY: Thank you. If you could also provide me with the numbers of the full-time equivalents for each agency at this point in time, that would be appreciated.

Mr Sedgwick: We do not necessarily have that data for each agency. We have it for some, but we do not necessarily have it for each of them. It is unpublished data and it is part of that report we provide to the minister. So we will have to take that on notice.

Answer:

Separation data by category of employment is not available as non-ongoing separations are contract-based. The following tables show data for ongoing employees only. Several tables have been provided - each showing separations by state, and then one or two of the variables requested.

This data is drawn from the Australian Public Service Employment Database (APSED). Monthly data is unaudited, apart from data in respect of the months of December and June. Comparisons between unaudited months need to be treated with some care. In particular, January 2014 to April 2014 data is based on 'live' APSED data and is unaudited and subject to revision. Movements in highly disaggregated monthly data may be potentially misleading.
