Answer:

Q1. There were no instances where an ANAO officer accompanied the Minister and/or Parliamentary Secretary on their travel.

Q2. The ANAO has spent \$529,354 on travel for the period 1 February – 31 May 2014. Travel of \$420,865 related to direct audit activities and \$108,489 related to travel associated with international engagements, audit conferences and meetings, corporate activities and professional development activities. The ANAO's travel management system does not record information to the level of detail requested.

Q3. The ANAO plans to undertake travel related to direct audit activities as set out in the respective audit work programs. The volume and timing of this travel can vary depending on the audit program and arrangements made with audited entities.
