Answer:

1.a. The total cost of building leases since 1 March 2014 to 31 May 2014 is estimated to be \$698,750 including GST.

The Australian Public Service Commission also has staff co-located with other Australian Government agencies in three locations (Brisbane, Melbourne and Perth). The co-location cost for this period is estimated to be \$57,370 excluding GST (no GST is charged by the agencies).
