Question:

1. How much did the department/agency spend on temporary or contract staff since September 7th 2013?

- 2. How many temporary or contract staff were employed since September 7th 2013?
- 3. How many temporary or contract staff are currently employed?
- 4. How much was paid for agencies/companies to find temporary/contract staff?
- 5. How much is budgeted in the 2014/15 year for contract staff?
- 6. What policies/criteria govern the appointment of Contract staff?
- 7. How is the use of contract staff consistent with a professional, independent public service?

Answer:

- Q1. The ANAO spent 2.4 million on temporary or contract staff for the period 7 September 2013 31 May 2014.
- Q2. There were a total of 46 temporary or contract staff employed in the period 7 September 2013 31 May 2014.
- Q3. There are 25 temporary or contract staff currently employed as at 31 May 2014.
- Q4. There were no additional expenses incurred in seeking the temporary/contract staff as the procurement was conducted through existing panels.
- Q5. The ANAO has budgeted \$3.044 million for the 2014/15 Financial Year for contract staff.
- Q6. Selection of contract staff are subject to normal Commonwealth procurement processes and the ANAO ensures each engagement represents value for money for the Commonwealth.
- Q7. Contract staff are engaged to meet workload peaks and provide specialist knowledge.
