Question:

- 1. How many applicants applied for the agency's 2014 graduate program? How many were accepted?
- 2. What is the anticipated intake of graduates for the beginning of the 2015 year?
- 3. Is this a reduction from the previous year? If so, what are the reasons for the decrease in the graduate intake?
- 4. Have any Government decisions affected the level of graduate intake in the agency?

Answer:

- Q 1-4 In 2013 the ANAO received 576 applications for the 2014 Graduate Program. 45 candidates were assessed as suitable, and the ANAO made offers for 18 positions and filled 16.
- Q2. The anticipated intake of graduates for the beginning of the 2015 year is yet to be decided. This includes consideration of the 2 positions identified for indigenous candidates.
- Q3. Overall this figure is an increase on the previous year.
