How many applicants applied for the agency's 2014 graduate program? How many were accepted?

Answer:

- 1. The Australian Public Service Commission (APSC) participated in the Indigenous Pathways Program, which coordinates graduate applications for participating agencies in the APS. From this process, 9 people preferenced the APSC (i.e. applied to participate in the APSC Graduate Program). Two graduates were engaged from this process for the 2014 Graduate program.
- 2. The Australian Public Service Commission anticipates engaging 2 Graduates in 2015, subject to the government's recruitment policy at the relevant time.
