Senator DASTYARI: I want to talk specifically about the decision that was made on 21 May 2014 to not attend an event at Deakin University. What role would the department have had in that? Was that directly between the PMO and the AFP? Or was the department involved in that decision?

Ms Kelly: I am not aware that we had a role, but I will take it on notice and make inquiries to confirm that that is the case.

Senator DASTYARI: If you were to have a role, would it have been you who would have had that role? Or would that be Dr Watt? How does it work?

Ms Kelly: I would need to find out whether we had a role before I would be able to speculate on where it lay. I can say that I am not aware of us having a role in relation to that.
