Answer:

The Project Agreement for Renal Infrastructure in the Northern Territory was signed by the Northern Territory Minister for Housing on 22 June 2015.

The project will provide long term family-centric renal accommodation for end-stage Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander renal patients and their families or carers in Alice Springs and Tennant Creek, and renal infrastructure and dialysis facilities in remote communities.
