On Friday 15 May 2015 a diesel spill was publicly reported at the Port Melville site.

When did the spill actually occur and when was the Tiwi Land Council made aware of the spill?

Answer:

The diesel spill occurred during the night of 11/12 May, caused by a faulty float valve in newly installed generators. The spill was reported to the TLC Environmental Manager and the GM Port Melville Pty Ltd at 10:26am on 12 May.
