Question:

AHL operates a Renal Hostel in Port Hedland.

- a. What is the primary purpose and occupancy rate of this hostel?

Are all, or the majority, of Aboriginal people using this service receiving medical treatment?

Answer:

The primary purpose of the South Headland Hostel is categorised as a Renal Hostel. The year to date room occupancy rate for this hostel is 78%.

The hostel primarily provides accommodation for clients who need to access South Headland's renal treatment facilities and other medical services.
