The Code of Conduct states that: Respecting the confidentiality of information is vital to ensuring the integrity of ASC's business and the trust of our stakeholders. ASC personnel must not misuse confidential information of ASC or any of its suppliers or customers or other third parties. Disclosure of any such confidential information should only be made where it is appropriately authorised or required by law or where the information is already in the public domain. This obligation continues after employees have left ASC.
