For each of the functional reviews that will be initiated for the following departments and agencies (as announced on 11 May 2015): Departments of Agriculture, Environment, Foreign Affairs and Trade, Treasury, Attorney-General's, Social Services; and the Australian Taxation Office and the Australian Bureau of Statistics:

- 1. When will the review start?
- 2. Will Finance staff be involved in these reviews? If so, will they be outposted into the relevant department/agency? How many staff members would be involved per review?
- 3. Will external contractors be involved? If so, how many per functional review?
- 4. Who will lead the review?
- 5. Who will be ultimately responsible for implementing any recommendations of the review?
