- 1. As at 28 May 2015, the number of ongoing and non-ongoing staff employed by the then Prime Minister, including the Cabinet Office, was 56.
 - a) The Department tabled a document at the Budget Estimates 2015-16 (Personal Positions as at 1 May 2015) which provides details of positions allocated to the then Prime Minister, including the Cabinet Office. The salary ranges and classifications applicable are provided in Attachments A and B of the *Commonwealth Members of Parliament Staff Enterprise Agreement 2012-2015* (the MOP(S) EA). Due to the possibility of individuals being identified, it would not be appropriate to provide further detail regarding individual employees.
 - b) e). There are no classifications for Advancers, speech writers or graphic designers in the MOP(S) EA. The duties performed by staff are determined by the Prime Minister.
 - f) Of the 56 staff employed as at 28 May 2015, 46.4% were male, 53.6% female.
- 2. As at 28 May 2015, six senior staff employed by the then Prime Minister were claiming a private plated vehicle. At that date, 22 senior staff employed by the then Prime Minister were receiving the Private-Plated Vehicle Allowance.
