Answer

- 1 To date, no formal dispute complaints between PBO employees have been made. Should disputes arise, they would be dealt with in accordance with relevant legislative mechanisms and PBO procedures.
- 2 No firms have been contracted to provide specific mediation services. The department's employee assistance program provider may provide mediation services if required, however this service has not been used for this purpose to date.
- 3 To date, no suspected breaches of the Parliamentary Service Code of Conduct by PBO employees have arisen. Should a suspected breach arise, it would be dealt with in accordance with section 15 of the *Parliamentary Service Act 1999* and the PBO's Procedures for Determining Suspected Breaches of the Parliamentary Service Code of Conduct.
