The Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade have advised that negotiations on the China-Australia Free Trade Agreement commenced in May 2005, negotiations on the Japan-Australia Economic Partnership Agreement commenced in April 2007, and negotiations on the Korea-Australia Free Trade Agreement commenced in May 2009.
