Senator McALLISTER: Does the website allow you to subscribe to receive updates on latest publications?

Mr Sheridan: I would have to check that. I provide the platform rather than the site itself.

Senator McALLISTER: Is there anyone here who can help?

Mr Sheridan: I could check very quickly.

Ms Hartland: I am being told it does not. We will double-check.

Senator McALLISTER: That is also my view. I was just checking whether I had got it wrong. **Ms Huxtable:** We will have to take it notice. ...

b)

Senator McALLISTER: Okay. So why would the Department of Finance construct a website that does not allow us to subscribe to information from the Department of Finance?

Ms Hartland: I expect it is just a lag. We are currently looking at the website, both the intranet and the internet. I would have to take it on notice, because it might be part of a next process for it. I do not know.

Answer:

- a) The website does not allow people to subscribe to receive updates.
- b) This feature was not available on the platform (Dreamweaver) when the website was constructed in 2007. The website was moved to a new platform (Drupal 7) in 2015. A subscription feature was available in Drupal 7 but was never built into the finance.gov.au website.

A subscription service for the department's website has therefore not been available but is a feature that will be considered in the future.
