The review commenced via an authorised officer of the AEC issuing a notice under s 316(2A) of the *Commonwealth Electoral Act 1918*, on 18 January 2017. The review is ongoing. In line with standard practice, the AEC does not comment on the status of compliance reviews that are currently underway.
