If so, has Department of Parliamentary Services done any checks to ensure that it is not using payroll companies that are being investigated by the Australian Taxation Office?

Does Department of Parliamentary Services have any standing protocols to ensure service providers it engages are not under investigation by the Australian Taxation Office?

Answer

DPS does not use any external payroll services.

The procurement process includes assessment of the suitability of the company being considered to provide the required goods and/or services. DPS does not have access to information on investigations into companies being undertaken by the Australian Taxation Office.
