Answer

'Car park patrol beyond the security perimeter of APH' refers to the patrols carried out by PSS officers in the House of Representatives, Senate and Ministerial staff car parks. The security perimeter referred to is that which is provided by the PSS at the entry points to the building where security screening occurs.
