Ms Hinchcliffe: As we answered in our question on notice, we have been provided 2.5 per cent Indigenous employment by 30 June 2018.

Senator McKENZIE: So we have been at 1.2 for how long? How long have we been static on 11 employees?

Ms Hinchcliffe: I will need to take that on notice.

Answer

The department has had 11 employees who have identified as indigenous in our HR system since 1 July 2016 (see table below).
