Following a security incident a debrief is held with the relevant personnel to evaluate the manner in which the incident was dealt with. Where shortcomings in procedures or policies have been identified measures are put in place to address those issues. Staff are made aware of any changes to procedures or policies through briefings from team leaders and additional advice placed in the Daily Brief or on the staff notice board.
