Please provide a list of to whom corporate credit cards and travel cards are issued.

#### **Answer**

DPS has the following three types of corporate credit cards for official business use:

- ANZ Visa card – used for general purchasing transactions;
- Diners Travel card – used in line with the Whole-of-Government (WoG) policy for payment of travel expenses including airfares, accommodation and car rental; and
- Diners companion MasterCard – used for general purchasing transactions.

As at 22 June 2017, DPS had 114 active credit cards on issue to staff. DPS cannot release the names of staff with issued credit cards for security reasons.

The number of cardholders, by card type, is in the table below.
