Senator WONG: So your understanding is that Minister Brandis did request that a new bookshelf be built, and Finance advised that they would not pay for it, that it would be a matter for his home department or for the Department of Parliamentary Services? **Ms Moy:** Finance advised DPS that it is not something that we would be paying for. **Senator WONG:** Thank you. In relation to Senator Brandis's electorate office, has the department built another bookcase in his electorate office? **Ms Moy:** Not to my knowledge. I could take that on notice.

Answer:
