- a) What are the details of the department/agency electricity purchasing agreement?
- b) What are the department/agency electricity costs from 7 September 2013 to date?

Answer

- a) Electricity for Parliament House is supplied through a Whole-of-Government (WoG) contract, which commenced on 1 July 2011. Price Schedules are Commercial-in-Confidence. The current electricity supplier to Parliament House is ERM Power Retail Pty Ltd, a publicly listed company that is both a power generator and retail provider.
- b) Electricity costs are invoiced per calendar month. The monthly costs are as follows:

September 2013 \$298,834.88 ex-GST
 October 2013 \$318,686.16 ex-GST
 November 2013 \$332,041.97 ex-GST
