  - b) Have printing costs increased, and if yes why and how much?
- 5. Has the five per cent savings target been achieved?
  - a) If yes, how, or if it will not, why not?
  - b) What are the estimated savings for each year over the forward estimates?

## Answer:

As a parliamentary department, the department is not part of the Australian Public Service and, therefore, efficiencies applied to that service do not directly apply to the department.
