As at 31 October 2014, 12 Executive Vehicle Scheme (EVS) vehicles, one ministerial vehicle and 22 pool vehicles are being leased by the Department. In addition, 159 vehicles are leased by the department for the COMCAR fleet.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">a) Vehicles leased through the Department’s EVS are garaged at the EVS participant’s home address. The vehicle provided to the Minister is garaged at Parliament House. The pool vehicles are garaged at the following locations:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">ACT - 15 NSW - 1 NT - 1 QLD - 1 SA - 1 TAS - 1 VIC - 1 WA - 1</p>

	<p>Details of the location of the COMCAR fleet are located as follows: ACT - 76 NSW - 29 NT - 1 QLD - 12 SA - 9 TAS - 2 VIC - 23 WA - 7</p> <p>b) Departmental pool vehicles are used for staff/equipment transport and other operational tasks. Vehicles leased by COMCAR provide secure, car-with-driver and related ground transport services.</p> <p>c) Departmental pool vehicles cost \$113,486.82 (GST inclusive). The Minister's vehicle costs are provided in QoN F41. EVS vehicle costs are not included in this answer as they are fully cost recovered. For COMCAR vehicles the average lease cost is \$4,717.35.</p> <p>d) The requested information is not available for this time period. For the period 28 May to 31 October COMCAR vehicles travelled an approximate average of 9,170 kms.</p>
