Finance	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. 48 graduates in January 2012 intake.</li><li>2. 24 graduates in January 2013 intake.</li><li>3. 28 graduates in January 2014 intake.</li><li>4. 28 graduates are expected in January 2015.</li></ol>
Australian Electoral Commission	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Eight graduates.</li><li>2. Four graduates.</li><li>3. No graduates.</li><li>4. Yet to be determined.</li></ol>
ComSuper	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Two graduates.</li><li>2. Four graduates.</li><li>3. ComSuper will not be taking on any graduates in 2014-2015.</li><li>4. ComSuper is scheduled to merge with the Commonwealth Superannuation Corporation on 1 July 2015. At this stage, there has been no decision regarding a possible graduate intake for 2015-2016.</li></ol>
