Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

- 1. How much has been spent on workplace ergonomic assessments?
  - a. List each item of expenditure and cost

1. For the period 28 May - 30 September 2014, a total of \$1,345.63 was spent on ergonomic assessments.
