Senator LUDWIG asked:

Since Budget Estimates in June, 2014:

- 1. How many ongoing staff have been recruited? What classification are these staff?
- 2. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created? What classification are these staff?
- 3. How many staff have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

Answer

- 1. Seven ongoing employees have been engaged since 6 June 2014. Their classifications are:
 - Australian Parliamentary Service Level 3 (1)
 - Australian Parliamentary Service Level 4 (1)
 - Australian Parliamentary Service Level 5 (1)
 - Australian Parliamentary Service Level 6 (3)
 - Parliamentary Executive Level 1 (1)
- 2. One non-ongoing position has been created since 6 June 2014. This position is at the Australian Parliamentary Service Level 1 classification and is an identified indigenous training position.

18 other non-ongoing positions exist in the department. The classifications of these positions are:

- Australian Parliamentary Service Level 1 (4)
- Australian Parliamentary Service Level 3 (5)
- Australian Parliamentary Service Level 4 (1)
- Australian Parliamentary Service Level 6 (8)

These employees generally support the work of the department during Senate sitting weeks including Senate Estimate hearings. A small number are engaged to support the Parliamentary Education Office.

The department employs either ongoing or non-ongoing employees. All non-ongoing employees are employed on contracts. Eleven non-ongoing employees have commenced with the department since 6 June 2014 on fixed-term contracts. The average length of their employment periods is approximately 11 months. Two non-ongoing employees commenced on irregular or intermittent contracts.
