Senator MILNE: Medicins Sans Frontieres said that they told the government prior to the government announcing more money that they did not want money; they wanted equipment. You have just said you cannot recall that, so I am asking in relation to Senator Wong specifically mentioning that organisation.

Ms Cross: We will take that on notice and check it, but a lot of the direct contact is with the health department and the health minister, rather than with PM&C, so we will have to take that on notice.....
