Question:

- 1. Can the Department provide an update to the committee on the scoping study for the Intra-Government Communications Network, or ICON?
- 2. If it does become privately owned, what are the potential revenue streams it could make for the owner?
- 3. Will the security of data be a key factor in whatever decision is made?
- 4. Can the Department advise what security classification level information can be transmitted over ICON?

Answer:

- 1. On 27 November 2015, the Government announced its decision to retain ownership of ICON.
- 2. Not applicable.
- 3. The scoping study took into account a range of relevant factors in forming its recommendations including security requirements.
- 4. ICON has physical security accreditation to PROTECTED. Agencies considering using ICON must conduct a risk assessment to ensure that:
 - security controls are sufficient to protect agency information;
 - identified risks associated with specific technologies, operating environments, and business functions are effectively managed; and
 - any residual security risks are identified and accepted.
