Finance utilises various plan options available via the Whole-of-Government Telecommunication Commodities, Carriage and Associated Services Panel 2011 (the Panel), depending on user requirements. The common plan that Finance utilises from the Panel is a \$54 per month plan, which includes allowances for both voice and data.
- 4. The Telecommunication Commodities, Carriage and Associated Services Panel was established in January 2011.
