Question:

How have Aboriginal Torres Strait Islander Coops sought to remain as Coops and still receive funding under the CIASG?

Answer:

A cooperative may apply for an exemption from the incorporation requirements to remain as a cooperative. Further information on the exemption policy is provided in the response to Question 8.

As at 10 November 2015, the Department has received applications from two cooperatives requesting an exemption from the incorporation requirements.

Many Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cooperatives will receive less than the \$500,000 (GST exclusive) grant funding threshold in all financial years and do not have to incorporate under Commonwealth legislation.
