Senator WONG: Is that the total Australian military engagement currently?

Mr McKinnon: That is.

Senator WONG: Without wanting to traverse anything that we cannot traverse in public, were

we aware of that prior to the US decision being made?

Mr McKinnon: Not to my knowledge.

Senator WONG: Subsequent to that decision, was the Prime Minister briefed about the

content of that decision?

Mr McKinnon: He was not briefed by Prime Minister and Cabinet. Senator WONG: To your knowledge, was he briefed by someone else?

Mr McKinnon: I would have to take that one on notice. Not to my knowledge.

## **Answer:**
