#### **Question:**

Senator WONG: So there is no limit on the size and scope—there is certainly a limit on the scope: you cannot use it for fundraising. That was as a result, I think, of some things which occurred under Prime Minister Howard. Are there other limitations around the size and scope of private functions at official residences?

Ms Spence: Not that I can think of, but I am certainly happy to take that on notice.

### Answer:

Use of the official residence for party political fundraising is not permitted. Costs relating to medium to large private functions are not met by the Commonwealth.
