## **Question:**

In his keynote speech at Garma this year, Northern Land Council CEO, Joe Morrison, said that the Minister has agreed not to reintroduce the regulation to devolve powers from NT Land Councils into the Senate.

- a) Is this correct?
- b) When did the Minister give this undertaking?

## **Answer:**

- a) Yes. The Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Amendment Bill 2015 was passed by Parliament in the Spring sittings 2015. This Bill amended the *Aboriginal Land Rights (Northern Territory) Act 1976* to improve the delegation of Land Council powers and functions for both Land Councils and applicants for delegations. The Northern Territory Land Councils received Exposure Drafts of the Bill and agreed to the amendments.
- b) The Minister wrote to the Northern Territory Land Councils on 3 March 2015 committing not to pursue regulations in regards to delegations of Land Council powers and functions until consultations on amendments to the Land Rights Act were undertaken. The amendments, developed through consultation, overtook the need for regulation.
