2) There have been no changes to the Department's existing shared service arrangements as a result of the leadership change.

3) The Department has shared service arrangements for corporate and enabling services with four Commonwealth Agencies.

The Department of Human Services (DHS) provides PM&C with select business and financial services including; credit card, fleet management, property, travel and select HR services including employee assistance, learning and development services and code of conduct investigations. As at 30 September, PM&C has paid DHS \$4m for shared services this financial year. The total cost for the 2014-15 financial year was \$18.6m.

The Department of Social Services (DSS) provides PM&C with select property services and ICT services including hosting PMC staff on their Unclassified ICT network, and providing grants management services including hosting grants systems FOFMS and GMS. As at 30 September, PM&C has not made any payments to DSS for shared services this financial year. The total cost for the 2014-15 financial year was \$14.6m.

The Department of Employment (Employment) provides PM&C with services associated with the hosting of the grants management system ESS, related systems and associated financial services. As at 30 September, PM&C has not made any payments to Employment for shared services this financial year. The total cost for the 2014-15 financial year was \$0.5m.

The Shared Services Centre (SSC), a partnering initiative established by the Department of Education and Training and the Department of Employment, provides PM&C with services associated with hosting of the grants management system INDIGO and associated financial and ICT services, property services as well as financial viability assessment services. As at 30 September, PM&C has not made any payments to SSC for shared services this financial year. The total cost for the 2014-15 financial year was \$0.4m.

There are no plans to change the existing shared service arrangements with the exception of property management. DHS currently manages PM&C properties for the Regional Network of the Indigenous Affairs Group. These services are transitioning back into PM&C via a contract with Jones Lang Lasalle as this is a more cost effective service delivery option.
