**Question:**

Ms Campbell: At Galiwinku, 80 houses require replacement following the cyclone, of which 47 will be paid for under the national partnership, NPARIH.

Senator PERIS: None of those have been built as yet?

Ms Campbell: I would have to get back to you to confirm. I do not know. I would expect that it has not been enough time.

**Answer:**

80 houses have been identified by the Northern Territory Government as requiring replacement at Galiwinku, with 47 to be funded under the National Partnership Agreement on Remote Indigenous Housing (NPARIH). As at 31 October 2015, construction of 20 of the 47 NPARIH houses is underway, but none has been completed.
