Question:

Please provide a breakdown of the funding sources available to Aboriginal health services.

Answer:

Aboriginal Health Services receive funding from multiple sources including Commonwealth departments, state/territory departments, fee for service revenue (including Medicare), Practice Incentive Payments (PIP), Primary Health Networks, philanthropic donations and from the private sector or other not-for-profit entities. However, neither corporations legislation nor financial statement standards specify that organisations must identify income sources separately and consequently detailed breakdowns are not available.

The Indigenous Australians' Health Program (IAHP) currently supports approximately 140 Aboriginal community controlled health services (ACCHS), including eight state/territory peaks and the National Aboriginal Community Controlled Health Organisation (NACCHO).
