Question:

What is the balance between the NIPE investments into its own pastoral interests and in southern Australia? What is that breakdown?

Answer:

The following table shows that National Indigenous Pastoral Enterprises (NIPE) Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of the ILC, operates the majority of its agribusinesses in northern Australia (13 of 14 businesses). The only business operating in southern Australia is a sheep station on Bruny Island, Tasmania.
