Please provide staffing information on:

- (a) The current organisation structure of the Office for Women (including teams/units)
- (b) The budgeted ASL, how many of these positions are currently filled and whether staff are permanent or on contract
- (c) The rate of turnover in the Office for Women over the past twelve months
- (d) The average rate of turnover for the Department of Prime Minister and Cabinet

Answer:

- (a) The current organisation structure of the Office for Women, including team structure, is provided at Attachment A.
- (b) As at 31 October 2016, the Office for Women had a 2016-17 budget ASL of 27. Within the Office for Women, 22 staff are ongoing, two are non-ongoing, three are seconded from other agencies and one is seconded from the private sector.
- (c) The total turnover rate for the Office for Women for the 2015-16 financial year for ongoing employees was 28.7 per cent.
- (d) The total turnover rate for the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet over the 2015-16 financial year for ongoing employees was 19.6 per cent
