- e) The nature of the work performed by labour hire staff.

Answer:

- a) Nine staff were employed using casual staff from labour hire firms.
- b) \$13,966.12 was spent on the provision of these casual staff.
- c) The firms engaged to supply these staff were Ross Human Directions, Wizard Personnel and Hays Recruiting.
