1. The Commonwealth Ombudsman undertook the first review of an examination conducted by the Director, FWBC on 13 September 2012.

The relevant documents to conduct this review were provided by FWBC to the office, on 26 July 2012 and the examination itself was conducted on 18 June 2012. As the review was conducted in the 2012-13 financial year, the findings of this review were reported in the 2012-13 Annual Report, tabled in Parliament in November 2013.
