- v. How far did each car travel from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?
- vi. How many cars are leased by each department/agency?
- vii. Where are the cars located?
- viii. What are the cars used for?
- ix. What is the cost of each car from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?
- x. How far did each car travel from Supplementary Budget Estimates in November 2013 to date?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

1. AGD owns and maintains a small fleet of civilian VIP protected vehicles. For operational security reasons it is inappropriate to disclose the number of vehicles.

3. These vehicles provide for the protected carriage of certain Australian high office holders, visiting foreign dignitaries and other internally protected persons as required.
4. The cost for the vehicles from 1 November 2013 to 12 March 2014 is \$147,372.00.
