ADDITIONAL ESTIMATES HEARING : 23 February 2015

IMMIGRATION AND BORDER PROTECTION PORTFOLIO

(AE15/035) - Children in Detention - Programme 2.1 Refugee and Humanitarian Assistance (Administered)

Senator Hanson-Young, Sarah (L&CA 67) asked:

Senator HANSON-YOUNG: Can you get the figures for how many have been transferred, throughout the course of the rest of day?

Ms Pope: Yes. What timeframe are you looking at?

Senator HANSON-YOUNG: Preferably before dinner.

Ms Pope: No, sorry, the timeframe of the numbers?

Senator HANSON-YOUNG: Since the report was released.

Mr Pezzullo: Can I also clarify: do you want the net numbers? Some children will have come to Australia and others would have been returned.

CHAIR: You can give us both.

Answer:

In the period 11 February 2015 to 12 March 2015, nine children were transferred to Australia from Nauru.

In the period 11 February 2015 to 12 March 2015, three children were returned to Nauru from Australia.
