Answer:

The Government announced its response to the Independent Review into Integrity in the 457 Programme on 18 March 2015.

The Government will act on the recommendations of the 457 Integrity Review to strengthen integrity in the programme, while also reducing cost and burden on employers needing to access the programme to address genuine skill shortages.

The Government has supported-in-principle the reinstatement of the Ministerial Advisory Council on Skilled Migration. The revised membership and terms of reference has not yet been announced.

The Department will act on the recommendations of the 457 Integrity Review by extending the sponsorship approval period for start-up businesses from 12 months to 18 months. The sponsorship approval period for other businesses will also be extended from three to five years.
