Senator Lambie asked the following question at the hearing on 9 February 2016:

Senator LAMBIE: Could I just ask a question related to that, just while they are putting questions on notice. I just want to know how many charges have been laid since the establishment. If you would like to put that on notice, I would just like to know how many charges have actually been laid.

Mr Colvin: Since the establishment of the Fraud and Anti-Corruption Centre?

Senator LAMBIE: Yes, please.

Mr Colvin: Yes, we should be able to find that.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

Since the inception of the Fraud and Anti-Corruption Centre on 1 July 2014, to 1 March 2016, four matters are currently before the court involving a total of 119 charges laid.

There have not been any finalised prosecution outcomes.
