#### Question No. AE16/106

## Senator Ludwig asked the following question at the hearing on 9 February 2016:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. For departments/agencies that provide mobile phones to Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices, what type of mobile phone has been provided and the costs?
  - 1. Itemise equipment and cost broken down by staff or minister classification
- 2. Has electronic equipment (such as iPad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive, video cameras) been provided by the department/agency? If yes provide a list of:
- 3. What is provided?
- 4. The purchase cost.
- 5. The ongoing cost.
- 6. A list of any accessories provided for the equipment and the cost of those accessories. (e.g. iPad keyboards, laptop carry bags, additional chargers etc.).
- 7. A breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives each item.

## The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- 1. The department generally provides iPhones to ministers and their staff as the standard mobile phone device. The purchase cost for an iPhone is currently approximately \$910.
- 2-7. The department provides the following electronic equipment, as required, to staff to assist them with carrying out their duties:
  - business card scanners
  - desktop PCs and laptop computers
  - desktop scanners
  - desktop speakers
  - desktop teleconference machines
  - digital cameras
  - digital voice recorders
  - facsimile machines
  - internet protocol (IP) phones
  - iPads
  - mobile phone devices (eg iPhone)
  - portable radio/stereo
  - printers/multi-function devices
  - remote access tokens
  - shredders
  - televisions
  - transcription equipment
  - USB storage devices
  - wireless internet dongles

• wireless telephone headsets

It would require an unreasonable diversion of resources to itemise equipment and costs for each item (including accessories) broken down by staff and/or staff classification.
