Senator McEwen, Anne (L&CA) written:

if Rolex watches with a total value of \$250,000 were transported to Australia by mail or parcel delivery, would the goods attract the same tax and duty charges referred to in question 3?

a) If not, what tax and duty charges would apply to such goods?

Answer:

Yes. Goods imported through the post or by air cargo would attract the same Customs Duty rate and Goods and Services Tax referred to in question 3 (see AE16/080).
